Position Summary

This position is responsible for operating and maintaining spray equipment according to specifications. Will blend chemicals according to labels.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Operates and maintains applicator in a safe and accurate manner.
- Performs necessary maintenance & calibration on assigned machines.
- Responsible for following the label when blending crop protection products to ensure quality chemicals.
- Reads maps, follows directions, and operates equipment with computer assisted operations.
- Provides accurate and efficient unloading and delivery of products.
- Assists sales agronomist with scouting fields to determine appropriate chemical mix, if necessary.
- Communicates with supervisor and agronomists about which fields to go to and what chemicals need to be sprayed.
- Compliance with all Safety, Environmental, and Operating Standards.
- Measure bulk tanks, loading and offloading bulk tanks.
- Active role in Preventative Maintenance Program on equipment.
- Ability to work extended hours during busy seasons including nights and weekends.
- Maintains company facilities, personal space, company equipment, and company vehicles; performing cleaning and maintenance to maintain a clean and safe environment for customers and co-workers.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience Required

- High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or one to three months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- CDL and an Applicator License are required within 3 months of hire date. Will assist in training and licensing.
